

Fr. Del . . . Points to Ponder

This week is a continuation of last week's column on *The Pastoral Constitution on the Church in the Modern World (Gaudium et Spes)*. I am hoping that you find it very helpful to see what the Fathers of the Second Ecumenical Council have to say about the place of church in the world today. You may find it on line at

The document is very readable, and here is just a taste of what the document says.

- As God did not create man for life in isolation, but for the formation of social unity, so also "it has pleased God to make men holy and save them not merely as individuals, without bond or link between them, but by making them into a single people, a people which acknowledges Him in truth and serves Him in holiness." So from the beginning of salvation history, He has chosen men not just as individuals, but as members of a certain community. Revealing His mind to them, God called these chosen ones "His people" (Ex. 3:7-12), and even made a covenant with them on Sinai. (¶ 32)
- Sacred Scripture teaches the human family what the experience of the ages confirms: that while human progress is a great advantage to man, it brings with it a strong temptation. For when the order of values is jumbled and bad is mixed with the good, individuals and groups pay heed solely to their own interests, and not to those of others. Thus, it happens that the world ceases to be a place of true brotherhood. In our own day, the magnified power of humanity threatens to destroy the race itself. (¶37)
- The family is, as it were, the primary mother and nurse of this education. There, the children, in an atmosphere of love, more easily learn the correct order of things, while proper forms of human culture impress themselves in an almost unconscious manner upon the mind of the developing adolescent. (¶61)
- God intended the earth with everything contained in it for the use of all human beings and peoples. Thus, under the leadership of justice and in the company of charity, created goods should be in abundance for all in like manner. (¶69)
- In many cases, there is an urgent need to revamp economic and social structures. But one must guard against proposals of technical solutions that are untimely. This is particularly true of those solutions providing man with material conveniences, but nevertheless contrary to man's spiritual nature and advancement. (¶86)

I hope that these past two columns have conveyed a sense of how readable these church documents are, giving you curiosity to examine the rich resources of the Second Vatican Council.

Oh, Now I Get It!

What in the world are next Sunday's readings about?

29th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Is 45: 1, 4-6 The Jewish people were in exile in Babylon when Cyrus, [the Gentile], king of Persia, conquered Babylon and released the exiles to return home. Not only that, but the fact that he allowed them to freely practice their religion and brought him to be seen as an unwitting servant of God called to restore Israel.

I Thes 1: 1-5b For the next four Sundays, we read from this epistle. It begins with a formal greeting from the three missionaries who had established this community. The Thessalonians were the "low maintenance children" of St. Paul, as evident by the praise he heaps upon them as he speaks of their diligence to live in faith, hope, and love. NOT IN WORD ALONE...

ALSO IN THE POWER OF THE HOLY SPIRIT:

It is not simply that the Thessalonians hear a message and agreed to accept it, but the power of the Holy Spirit brought them to accept it and empowered them to live it.

Mt 22: 15-21 We have heard on the past Sundays about the increasing tension between some of the religious leaders & Jesus. "YOU TEACH THE WAY OF GOD...": Clearly they are saying this to flatter Jesus with words they do not at all believe. "NOT CONCERNED WITH ANYONE'S OPINION ... REGARD A PERSON'S STATUS": This the leaders do know, since Jesus does not simply quote from the Law and the Prophets, but brings it to fulfillment. He speaks with an authority unheard of before.
"...LAWFUL TO PAY THE CENSUS TAX TO CAESAR?": If Jesus says the people should pay the tax, He will lose a great number of followers; if He says they shouldn't pay, the leaders can turn Him into the Roman authorities as a seditionist. "SHOW ME

tax, He will lose a great number of followers; if He says they shouldn't pay, the leaders can turn Him into the Roman authorities as a seditionist. "SHOW ME THE COIN ... CENSUS TAX": If they have the coin in their possession, it means that they pay that tax. They have the coin on them which means they pay the tax. "GIVE TO CAESAR ...": While none of the people favored Roman rule, they accepted it as fact of life by the use of Roman coinage; therefore, give to the ruler what is his. "... WHAT IS GOD'S": Unasked for advice from Jesus. Everything is God's, especially His Chosen People. Therefore, they owe everything to Him.




